

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1.2 CVCe Words - Split Diagraphs



Today, we are going to learn about a special kind of words called 'CVC + e words'.

First, let's break down what CVC + e means. 'CVC' stands for consonant-vowel-consonant. It means that we have three letters in a row, with the first letter being a consonant, the second letter being a vowel, and the third letter being another consonant. For example, <u>cat</u> is a CVC word because it has the consonant 'c', the vowel 'a', and the consonant 't'.

Now, let's move on to the '+ e' part. The '+ e' means that we add an 'e' at the end of a CVC word to change its sound. This 'e' is very special because it works like a magic wand and transforms the vowel sound in the middle of the word.

For example, let's take the CVC word <u>tap</u>. When we add the magic 'e' at the end, it becomes <u>tape</u>. Do you see how the 'a' in <u>tap</u> changes to a long 'a' sound in <u>tape</u>? The 'e' makes the vowel say its own name!

We can find lots of other examples of CVC + e words. Let's try a few more:

'hop' + 'e' = <u>hope</u> (The 'o' in 'hop' changes to a long 'o' sound in 'hope'.) 'win' + 'e' = <u>wine</u> (The 'i' in 'win' changes to a long 'i' sound in 'wine'.) 'cap' + 'e' = <u>cape</u> (The 'a' in 'cap' changes to a long 'a' sound in 'cape'.)

If you want to make it more fun, you can play a game with your classmates. Write down CVC words on one side of the board and take turns adding the magic 'e' to make it a CVC + e word on the other side. It's like a word magic show!

The "magic e" changes the sound of the vowel from a short sound to a long sound.



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

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


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
